



# Assemble the Lamp



- I Screw the base pipe to the base.
- 2 Then screw the lower lamp body to the base pipe, then screw the upper body onto the lower body.
- 3 Screw the socket assembly onto the upper body.
- 4 Screw the adjustable threaded pipe onto the socket assembly.
- Screw the lamps into the sockets. Refer to the label on the lamp socket for Max Wattage Information.
- 6 Place the shade onto the adjustable threaded pipe and secure in place by screwing the finial onto the pipe.
- Loosen the height lock on the adjustable threaded pipe, adjust to desired height, and tighten the height lock to secure in place.
- 8 Lamps may be turned on and off independently with individual pull chains.
