



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Install the Fixture



- I Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- 2 Place the shade onto the studs on the socket assembly, then insert the studs through the fixture base, and secure in place using the washers and cap nuts.
- 3 Connect the fixture ground wire to a suitable ground in accordance to local electrical codes.
- 4 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 5 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- Properly place all wires and wire nut connections into the junction box/fixture base, mount the fixture onto the mounting plate, and secure it in place using the fixture screws.
- Screw the lamp into the socket. Refer to the label on the lamp socket for Max Wattage Information.
- 8 Screw the plate to the fixture arm.
