

PRE-ASSEMBLY:

- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protecting packaging
- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

• Clean with soft, dry cloth. Always avoid the use of harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners as they may cause damage to the lamp.



TO ASSEMBLE:

- 1. Remove all packing contents and parts from the cartons carefully.
- 2. Pull excess wire through the column before assembling the lamp.
- 3. Unscrew washers(i1) and threading nuts(J) off the colomn by wrench(L).
- 4. Place the column(B) onto the base(A), then use 2pcs washer(i1) and thread $\operatorname{nut}(J)$ to tighten the base by wrench(L).
- 5. Unscrew the handle(K) off, take off washers(i3)(i4) carefully, and attach arm(D) to the top of column(B). Then, put on washers(i3)(i4) tighten them with handle(K) until secure
- 6. Hang the socket assembly (E) onto the slot of arm(D) carefully.
- 7. Unscrew the socket ring(G) off the socket, then attach diffuser(F) and shade (H) to the socket, then tighten the shade by using socket ring(G).
- 8. Hang the loader(C) on the other end of arm(D) until secure.
- 9. Insert 1 type A 150w bulb (or suitable cfl 35w or led 28w bulb ,not included) into the socket. Do not exceed specified wattage.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

For safety purposes, this lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) (For North America Customers Only). If the plug does not fit securely into your outlet, do not force it — contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way. This instruction is provided for your safety. It is important that it is read carefully and completely before assembling the fixture.

To avoid risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

WARNING:

- To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing the bulb.
- Do not touch bulb when fixture is turned on. Do not look directly at lit bulb. Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.
